A project's environmental, social and human rights impacts play an important role when it comes to deciding whether export transactions are eligible for support within the scope of a buyer credit line. For this reason the projects are reviewed in accordance with the environmental and social guidelines of the OECD (Common Approaches) and those of the Federal Government. In the course of an initial screening all applications are examined for the potential environmental, social and human rights impacts of the respective project. Any projects that are covered by the Common Approaches are assigned to one of the Categories A, B or C. More detailed information on the assessment procedure can be found on the <u>AGA website</u>.

Please note that in the context of the environmental, social and human rights assessment **project always denotes the project as a whole**, for which German supplies and services are intended. The assessment is site and project-related. This means that deliveries and services for one site or one project are assessed on the basis of their cumulative value and thus only one questionnaire per site has to be completed.

In the course of the application procedure, further questions regarding the project's impacts may arise. Above all, this questionnaire does not replace the information required for specific sectors (for that, please, see also the **sector-re-lated checklists** at www.agaportal.de > Quick Links > Responsibility).
