

Cover Policy for Defence Projects (non-official translation)

Cover is available for exports of war weapons¹ and other defence equipment² to the following countries:

- Customs territory of the EU, certain NATO member states³, NATO-equivalent countries⁴ und other countries⁵
- Third countries⁶

Cover for other military goods is determined on the merits of the individual case based on a preliminary inquiry.

No cover is available for exports to embargoed countries in accordance with Section 74 (1) of the Foreign Trade and Payments Ordinance (AWV).

Further information:

- For exports to third countries, a specific indication is obtained from the Federal Government based on a preliminary inquiry (prior to the formal application process). This inquiry is free of charge and can be submitted informally. Following a positive indication, the formal application procedure can be initiated.
- For exports of war weapons to "other countries", a specific indication is obtained from the Federal Government based on a preliminary inquiry.
